### Traffic Light Scheme.

To help us plan for the longer term we are desperately trying to get Lodges and Chapters to make a 5 year pledge to support TLC in Surrey. We are not asking for a huge sum in one go, just a small, manageable amount each year from as many lodges as possible.

Going RED means a donation of £50 per year over 5 years (total of £250), ideally suited to Chapters.
